



# POSITION ANNOUNCEMENT

**Open Position:** Wastewater Treatment Plant Operations (3<sup>rd</sup> Shift)

**Application Deadline:** Full consideration given to applications received by 4:30 p.m. on Wed., Feb. 10, 2016

Applications are now being accepted for Wastewater Treatment Plant operations personnel. This is a 3rd shift position, scheduled from 10 p.m. to 6 a.m. with rotating weekends. This position monitors unit processes and performs all operational duties necessary for the proper operation of the Wastewater Treatment Plant. If not currently certified in wastewater treatment by the state of Kentucky, this individual will be required to progress toward certified operator status by training and preparing for certification testing. Essential functions include:

- monitoring gauges, meters and control panels to ensure proper equipment operation
- utilizing computer systems to monitor automated plant operating systems, remote facilities, and security systems
- performing preventative maintenance on equipment as needed
- operating various equipment, including pumps, valves and controls on unit processes
- conducting sampling during the treatment process
- making adjustments to process upsets, mixing chemicals required in treatment, and performing basic tests
- recordkeeping related to testing and maintenance
- performing other duties which may be assigned

**Skills and Qualifications:** This individual must be able to perform duties efficiently and effectively without direct supervision. The work requires moderate physical effort to perform manual labor tasks. Work will be performed outside subject to prevailing weather conditions. This individual must be able to operate a front-end loader, dump truck, air packs, and all operations equipment found in a secondary wastewater treatment plant. The work environment involves proximity to untreated wastewater, and requires the individual to follow prescribed safety practices and to use safety equipment such as gloves, hard-toe shoes, respirators, SCBA or air-line supplied respirator, and protective clothing such as tyvek suits. Use of computers with standard office software is required. Competency in basic math is required.

**Minimum Requirements:** A high school diploma or graduate equivalency. A valid Kentucky driver's license is required. Must have the ability to obtain wastewater treatment certification by the state of Kentucky.

**Preferred Characteristics:** Possession of certification by KY Division of Water as a wastewater treatment plant operator (Class I, II, III, or IV). Experience using backhoe, forklift, and Bobcat.
